

# Post 16 Funding – for CYPs with a disability



So, you have decided now what to do after Year 11, but you need help with funding for support, equipment and transport.

There are different sources of funding

- Personal Independence Payment (PIP)
- Apprenticeship Funding
- Disabled Students Allowance – for those in Further Education
- Access to Work Fund

## Personal Independence Payment (PIP)

Disability living allowance has changed and is now called PIP. This is funding for those aged 16-18 who are in Further Education (College) or other placements.

## Apprenticeship Funding

This is funding for those aged 16-18 who are on an Apprenticeship
